

DRUG COURT WAIVER

By allowing my case to be transferred to drug court I agree to the following conditions and waive the following rights:

1. Waiver of Search and Seizure Rights.

I acknowledge and agree in writing to be subject to search and seizure of my person, vehicle, or residence by drug court assigned law enforcement personnel, or a court bailiff, at any time of the day or night, with or without a search warrant and with or without probable cause. I understand that this includes drug testing

2. Waiver of Attorney Privileges.

I understand that my defense attorney's duties change once I am in drug court. My defense attorney will not be required to advocate my position as I see it. My defense attorney will make an independent decision regarding what is best for me and will be honest with the court and myself regarding that recommendation. Further, my attorney will share information regarding myself and my case(s) with the drug court team.

3. I Will Be Pleading Guilty.

I understand that in drug court I will be required to admit the crimes charged in this case.

4. I Have a Drug Problem.

I understand that by entering drug court I acknowledge that I have a drug addiction. An addiction to marijuana and/or alcohol alone, does not qualify for felony drug court.

5. I Understand That I am Subject to Sanctions including Release Revocation w/o Affidavit or Hearing.

From the moment I sign below, I understand that If I do not remain clean and sober or otherwise comply with drug court rules, I may be sanctioned by the court without the court receiving an affidavit specifying the violation or without the court holding a hearing. Sanctions may include revocation of pretrial or bond release, incarceration, fines, community service, and/or increased treatment requirements.

6. I Understand Drug Court Is A Program of Abstinence.

I cannot take pain killers or any other prescription that may test positive as a controlled substance. If I am on Suboxone or Methadone, I will need to be seen at Project Reality immediately to safely taper off of those substances.
